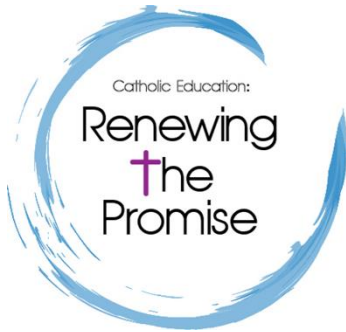


Catholic Education Week
