The council agreed to pay for 2017/18 agendas (\$1,300), subsidy for year-end trips (\$5 per child, total \$1840.00), June Fun Fair 2017 (about \$1000), Garden Woodchips/Screening/Dirt to elevate the area (\$1000.00), Graduation Award (\$50), year-end donation that totals 10% of all funds raised (Make A Wish Foundation in name of Massotti family) (\$500), Spirit Wear contributions (\$2 per shirt, \$800 total), Math/board games for classrooms (\$50 per classroom, \$750), Gym/Outdoor Equipment (\$1580.00), and carryover for about \$100.00 from this budget amount.
