4.0 Declaration of Interest

Members discussed poinsettia fundraiser options. Vendors and prices were compared. Council decided on P. Ravensbergen. This year we will <u>only</u> be selling *two poinsettia sizes*. We will not be selling wreaths or planters this year. Council will be selling a 6 inch (single poinsettia) for \$10.00, with the option of 4 colours (white, pink, red and marble) and an 8 inch (double poinsettia) for \$22.00 with the option of 3 colours (white, pink, and red). Forms will be sent out to the community on Monday November 5th, and will be returned by Friday November 16th. Council will be asking the vendor to deliver the poinsettias to the school during the week of December 3-6. Suzy will be responsible for creating the order form. Mr. Coons will see if this fundraiser can be accessed online through cashless. Motion by Suzy and seconded by Christine for fundraising for poinsettias and provider. It was approved by council.

As an incentive Council discussed offering 3 free separate 8 inch poinsettias for families who order online through cashless and a top seller gift card for Cineplex Odeon. Council is budgeting \$100.00 for prizes. Motion by Christine and seconded by Suzy. Motion was approved.

Christine will look into the cost for approximately 150 coloured copies. Budget \$100.00. Motion by Adriana and seconded by Suzy.

Parent council will be setting up a table to advertise the poinsettia fundraiser on the evening of parent teacher interviews on November 15th. Grade 8's can make a sign for the front table.

Visit with Santa event- Saturday December 8th, 2018, 10:00-12:00pm

Christine will be looking into cost for breakfast/ cookies with Santa with her school principal Council discussed making a craft with Santa (ornament). Council was thinking of making the ornaments and then bringing them to an elderly/hospital/retirement home. Enza will take pictures with the school camera. We will need to set up a craft table, hand out candy canes, Grade 8's dressed up as elves, choir available to sing Christmas carols. Council discussed providing treats and refreshments. We will look into the cost of regular and chocolate milk, coffee and tea. Council asked Mr. Coons to get some grade 8 students to set up tree and decorate it. Mrs. Smith will be looking into getting coffee and hot chocolate donated, as well as borrowing the Christmas bizarre set up. Council will purchase the treats. Mrs. Smith will ask ED to come as Santa.
