It was mentioned that the "Bring your own fork" initiative was not successful.

Chrome books were ordered through Staples. Parent Council purchased 15 chrome books. The cost per laptop was \$276.00. Parent Council will create the themed baskets. Council will not be asking for students to get donations this year. Each class will given a theme and will be asked to bring in items to create the baskets.

A spring photobooth will be created. Pictures will be taken on an Ipad and will be printed off at a later date and sent home with the students a week later. Students will be charged \$1.00 per photo.

All teachers will be given incentive items to hand out during the dance (i.e glow sticks, sparkly necklaces, glowing items, etc). These will be used to motivate students to dance at the event.

Students will be charged 3 tickets for \$1.00

Dana Lauricella will order 20 dozen cookies (240) to sell at the Spring Dance. We will order 10 dozen rainbow cookies, and 10 dozen chocolate chip cookies. Motion to approve \$150.00 for cookies, by Christine DeGregorio and seconded by Dana Lauricella.

This year parent council discussed printing off tickets with the teacher's names. Students will just need to write their name and first initial on ticket. This could help cut down time when writing the tickets.

A letter will be sent home to parents on March 30, 2020. Items will be asked to be brought in between April 6 to April 17.

We will discuss finances for the event at the next parent council meeting.
