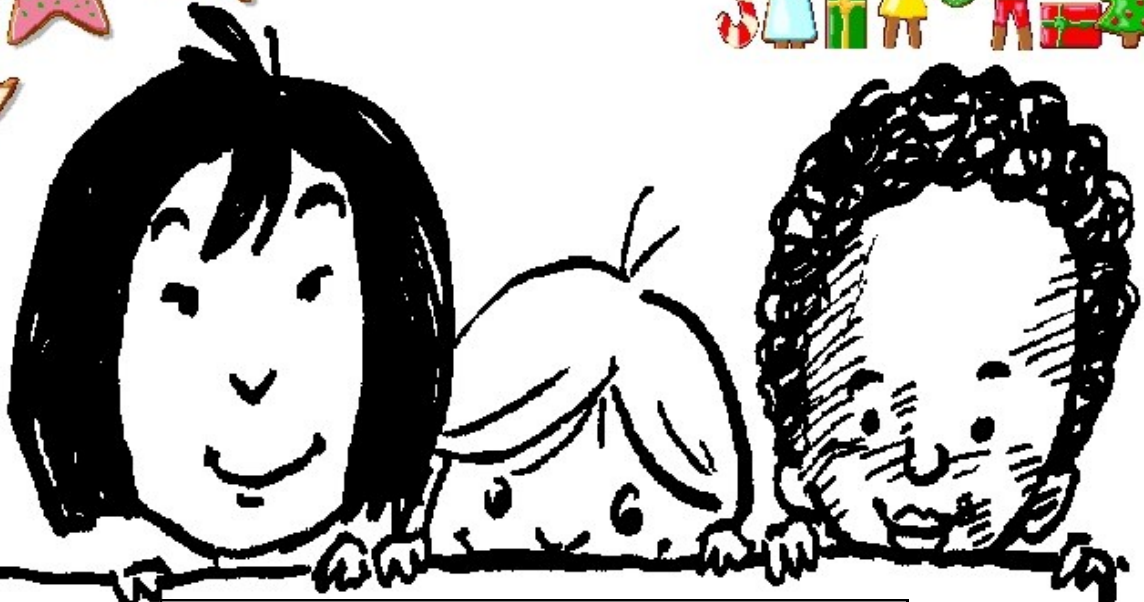
There will be the White Elephant Shop, Crafts and Bake Table.
